

WLIA Parcel Data Modeling Task Force

Mission & Goals

Over the next year, the WLIA Parcel Data Modeling Task Force will do the necessary research, analysis, and coordination to publish and present a report on best practices and suggested data models for developing published interoperable parcel mapping across Wisconsin.

To achieve the Mission, the Task Force will:

1. Recruit members representing a range of experience and technical expertise.
2. Document existing parcel data models, practices and policies.
3. Analyze and document current trends in parcel maintenance, spatial database migration and publishing.
4. Re-visit and compare the WLIA Parcel/Cadastral Data Content Standard with current suggested exchange models (e.g. FGDC Framework Standard, ArcGIS Parcel Geodatabase Model (GIS for the nation).)
5. Re-visit current recommendations of the FGDC Cadastral Data Subcommittee.
6. Develop and make available a proposed interoperable spatial database model for publishing and exchange of parcel information.
7. Recommend best practices for current and future parcel data maintenance and publishing.
8. Maintain on appropriate websites Task Force meeting agendas, minutes, reports, and related documents.
9. At public events, regularly report on the Task Force's progress.
10. Present conclusions and recommendations at the June 2008 WLIA Regional Meeting
11. After WLIA approval, report to the anticipated Wisconsin Geographic Information Council.
12. Other tasks as necessary to fulfill mission.
