### Workshop 10 – Parcel Fabric 601 - Advanced Parcel Fabric

This three hour workshop will explore the more advanced topics associated with implementing and using the ESRI ArcGIS Parcel Editing Solution (aka the Parcel Fabric.) Topics include: quality control in the Parcel Fabric, Cartographic Point Management, Control Points, identifying and fixing topology errors, advanced construction techniques, associated layers, ETL Procedures, updating control points and its impact and an exploration of adjustment techniques. Since the topics covered in this workshop are advanced in nature and not familiar to users not using the Parcel Fabric, it is highly recommended that attendees be familiar with the Parcel Fabric prior to attending this workshop.
